2. Durability
 - Not less than ten (10) years
3. Warranty
 - Two years from the date of successful delivery for manufacturing defects and insufficient workmanship.
4. Materials
 - The materials used have all been chosen to give a perfect balance for maximum durability and yet making it a portable system.
 - All the visual elements comply with international standards and reflective material is also used to add maximum visibility under poor lightning conditions.
5. Electrical systems
 - The trailer has an "External Power Input" socket to recharge the on-board battery, as well as the batteries or the warning lights.
 - When the rear lid of the trailer is opened, the blue lights mounted onto the two halves of the lid, start to flash.
 - The extension leads can be plugged into the two "Generator output (220 VAC)" sockets to supply power for the two floodlights.
 - An electrical DB box is included with an earth leakage safety trip switch.
 - Two trip switched prevents short circuits. An hour meter is provided to monitor intervals between servicing the generator.
6. Design
 - Customized design as per the need of the user.
7. Sampling and Compliance with the specifications

Sampling

The following sampling procedure shall be used to determine compliance with the relevant requirements of this specification

 - Bidders need to submit with their Bid, one (1) sample for functional evaluation by Hessequa Municipality, Department Protection Services.
 - This must be done, by presenting the trailer on the day of submitting the trailer for inspection (you must take it back after submitting of tender proses is done)
 - Non-compliance to this will invalidate the Bid.
6. Markings
 - The finished K78 roadblock trailer must be permanently marked on the vehicle with the markings as indicated by Hessequa Municipality, Department Protection Services.

8. Locks
 - The door of the trailer must be able to lock and the service provider will provide At least two (2) locks with keys to Hessequa Municipality
9. Delivery
 - The Finished K78 trailer will be registered and licenced in the name of Hessequa Municipality, and delivered in Riversdale.
 - The service provider shall handover the registration documentation to the Fleet manager of Hessequa Municipality on delivery.

2. 1 X Expandable Barrier

Description

1. Must be highly visible with red and white Retro reflective strips on both sides, visible in night and day time
2. Must be able to expand to minimum of 5 meters in length
3. Must not weigh more than 9 kg, and when expanded it must be able to stand on its own
4. When not in use, it must be able to fold up to not less than 1 meter.
5. Must have its own carrier bag for storage purposes.

3. 1 X Emergency Road Flare

Description

1. Must have at least 16 LED lights in one flare
2. Must be able to give 360-degree coverage
3. Must be able to illuminate at a distance of at least 300 meters in day light and 800 meters at night
4. Must be able to withstand all weather conditions (must be able to use it in rainy conditions)
5. Must have at least 9 flash patterns
6. Must be able to submerged under water

Operational conditions

1. Must be able to withstand a vehicle driving over it
2. Must be able to withstand temperatures of at least 40°C to 100°C
3. Must be able to work for at least 100 hours after being fully charged
4. Must have a battery shelf life of at least 10 years
5. Must be able to be recharged
6. Must have a weight of not more than 0.2 kg
7. Must have a diameter of not less than 10.8 (dial) and 3.5cm (height)
8. Must be able to be clipped on the clothing of a officer
9. Must have a magnate and be strong enough to be placed on a vehicle
