

DISPOSAL OF REDUNDANT FLEET VEHICLES AND LOOSE ASSETS

PURPOSE OF REPORT / DOEL VAN VERSLAG

That Council approve that the redundant fleet vehicles, and movable assets be placed on the next public auction for disposal.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION / AGTERGROND EN BESPREKING

The Hessequa Municipality maintains a fleet of vehicles to ensure optimal service delivery within the approved service standards. Vehicles are evaluated bi-annually to assess their economic life and running costs. When it is determined that a vehicle has reached the end of its economically useful life or its maintenance costs become uneconomical, disposal is considered. In the current evaluation, six vehicles meet these criteria due to high maintenance costs and operational inefficiency.

Table 1 consist of a list of the fleet vehicles that have been evaluated and recommended for disposal due to mechanical failure, structural damage, or uneconomical maintenance. These units have been decommissioned and are currently parked at the Riversdale Power Station.

As a result, the units are considered beyond economical repair.

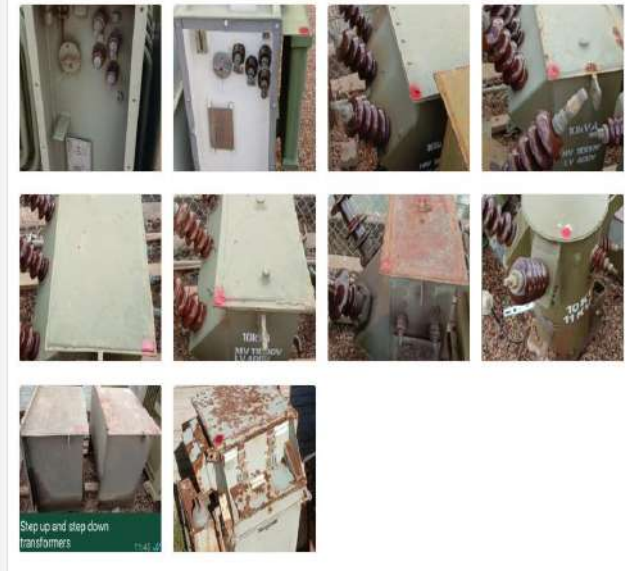
